
# Who We Serve

Children's Bereavement Center is proud to offer our **completely free grief support groups** to children, teens and adults struggling with the death of a significant person.

Groups are held weekly in the evenings and we provide a free dinner before groups begin. CBC is now expanding our services to reach Spanish-speaking children and families.







Of those who reported, CBC's largest ethnic community is Hispanic/Latino.



Of those who reported, the majority of CBC participants have an annual household income of \$10,000-\$25,000.


