For over 20 years, the Children's Bereavement Center has served our South Florida community offering free support groups for children, teens and adults who have lost a loved one.

Social isolation due to COVID-19 takes its greatest toll on those who are grieving - missing funerals, memorials and the comfort of friends. CBC launched VIRTUAL grief support groups immediately after the onset of the pandemic, which are accessbile every week from the safety of one's own home. Participation remains FREE for anyone who has lost a significant person in their life, including those who have lost someone due to COVID-19.
