As Children's Bereavement Center (CBC) celebrates our 25th anniversary, we hope you will join us as a sponsor of our annual Steps for Healing 5K on Saturday, November 23, 2024. The U.S. Surgeon General released an Advisory last year on the Healing Effects of Social Connection and Community referring to the "Epidemic of Loneliness and Isolation." In the State of Florida alone, one in 11 children experience the loss of a parent or sibling before the age of 18. This number more than doubles by the age of 25, which can lead to psychological and physiological health implications, including feeling a lack of support and loneliness. CBC's groups bring people together for connection and community to inspire hope and resiliency after experiencing a loss, while being diverse, inclusive, and welcoming to all so that **no one has to grieve alone**.

Steps for Healing attracts 1,000 participants for in-person and virtual races combined. Our group participants and families who have suffered a loss look forward to this event every year as an opportunity to memorialize their loved ones. Through our event marketing, thousands of people learn about CBC as an accessible, free grief resource. Sponsors will be showcased on our race website, running app, in marketing materials, in promotional email messages, on-site at the event, on race t-shirts and across social media platforms.

For over 25 years, CBC has provided free grief support to thousands of people. We are grateful for your generosity and partnership as together we will ensure that CBC can continue to be here for our community for years to come, providing grief support to all.
